# District Procedure

**OPERATIONS**

**OPS-EMS – 505.1**

**Equipment Exchange**

**Issued: May 13, 2014**

## PURPOSE:

To set a procedure for exchanging of disposable items used on the call, with the transporting Medic or with the WVMC Hospital. We have a verbal agreement with transporting Medic unit to exchange disposal equipment used on the call. (The exception is with Metro West). We also have a verbal agreement with MVMC to exchange pillows, blankets, and leave contaminated materials at the hospital if you transport.

## PROCEDURE:

1. Before the transporting medic leaves or before you leave the hospital and as you are cleaning up, you are allowed to exchange one blanket for one blanket and one pillow for one pillow.
2. Any contaminated disposable equipment can be bagged and left in a proper container at the hospital, or given to the transporting medic or returned to the station for disposable.
3. Any non-disposable equipment needs to be cleaned at the hospital or bagged and returned to the station and cleaned.

## RESPONSIBILITY:

1. It is the responsibility of all crewmembers to assure the equipment is restored and the responsibility of the tech to assure that the crews have done their jobs.
