4. YFPD provided EMS coverage at the Fair on July 30th & August 2nd.
5. Working with the auditor to get things ready for the audit. They will be here in August 16th, 2019 to do the onsite work.
6. The Specs for the New Engine were completed and put out for RFP on July 26th, 2019. RFP's are due back no later than 1:00 pm on August 28 and the RFP opening will be done at 2:00 pm at the Yamhill Fire Station. Then we will review each RFP to make sure they completed the needed requires and will have the results at the September 9th, 2019 Board Meeting for the Board to review and at that time give an intent to award. If the intent is done on the 9th we could sign the contract on the 16th.
7. We had 5 new volunteers go thru the EMR class with 3 of them completed and passed the testing. The other 2 have completed and passed the written test and just need to finish the hands-on test.
8. The Volunteers worked with Yamhill PD and had a good National Night Out at the Park on August 6th. Served 300 hamburgers and 30 to 40 lbs. of Hot Dogs.

9. The Volunteers will be doing the Breakfast with Santa on December 7, 2019 with the theme of "Polar Express".
10. November 7th thru the 9th, 2019 is the Oregon Fire Service Conference in Seaside. All five Board Members are scheduled to go. We will leave on November 6th and will be staying at the Shilo Inn.
11. The tires sold on e-bay for \$305.00. They have been paid for and picked-up.
12. We were awarded the VFA Grant which is a 50/50 Grant. The total is \$16,600. This is for 10 new portable radio's and 10 new pagers which we will order sometime in October.
13. Working on the contract for the new Air Packs, with the goal to order in the next couple of months.
14. Working with McMinnville Fire for them to take over providing the equipment and overseeing the EMS coverage for the Yamhill County Fair
