Education and Training

Issued: August 12, 2014

The District shall encourage and promote continued education and training for volunteers to enhance job performance and assist in potential career advancement within the District. The District shall provide such in-service training as deemed necessary and beneficial to the delivery of services and performance of duties.

Volunteers may request compensation for the costs of college-level, technical or other academic course work, seminars, and conferences relevant to their current or future roles with the District. Such requests must be made in writing to the Training Officer. Such requests shall be forwarded by the Training Officer, accompanied by a recommendation to the Fire Chief for approval or disapproval prior to the volunteer's enrollment or participation. Reimbursement for college-level course work will only be made if the volunteer receives a passing grade. All training activities involving a cost to the District must be approved in advance, in writing.
