Definition of Non-Disciplinary Appeal

Issued: August 12, 2014

If a volunteer or group of volunteers in the District believes and injustice has occurred because of:

1. Lack of a District policy;
2. A policy is unfair;
3. Misapplication of a policy;
4. Disagreement with another volunteer or supervisor;
5. A discretionary action of the District in the application of the rules and regulations of the District; or
6. Discrimination on the basis of race, religion sex, color, age, sexual orientation, national origin, marital status, familial status, mental/physical disability, source of income, expunged juvenile record; association with anyone of a particular race, religion, sex, color, age, sexual orientation, national origin, marital status, family relationship, mental/physical disability, source of income, expunged juvenile record, mental or physical handicap, or application for Workers' Compensation benefits; then a written request may be filed with the Fire Chief for a hearing.
