District Policies

VOLUNTEER

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Physical Examinations

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Appointments by the District may be made contingent upon an applicant's successful completion of a medical examination to determine if the applicant is able to perform a volunteer's essential functions with or without reasonable accommodation and without direct threat to the health or safety of the applicant or other persons. If required, this examination will be provided by the District at the District's expense. Any information gathered will be treated as a confidential medical record. The scope of the post-offer medical examination need not be limited to an applicant's ability to perform essential job functions and may include a base-line physical exam and other inquiries into the applicant's physical and/or mental condition.

In order to ensure continued qualification for volunteer service, the District may request volunteers to submit to a medical examination or screening when the request is job related and consistent with business necessity at the District's expense.

If a medical examination is required, the District will follow NFPA 1500, 1582, and 1583.
