Attendance and Punctuality

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The performance of each volunteer is important to the overall success of the District operations. When absent, someone else must do the job. Everyone is expected to keep regular attendance, be on time, and serve as scheduled.

In accepting volunteer association with the District, each volunteer is required to meet certain standards. Maintaining an acceptable level of attendance is part of good performance and is one of the standards by which a volunteer's overall contribution to the District may be measured. Continued association carries with it the personal responsibility of each volunteer to serve as scheduled, and to respond to calls whenever available.

Recurring and excessive absences and/or tardiness is disruptive to others and is detrimental to the morale and efforts of volunteers who maintain a good attendance record. Failure to meet these requirements subjects a volunteer to appropriate disciplinary action, which may include termination. The ability to attend drill and training sessions regularly, and respond to alarms whenever available, is a requirement of every volunteer.
