# District Policies

**Driving Record**

**Issued: June 10, 2014**

Volunteers who may be required to drive must possess a valid Oregon Drivers License and must comply with any operator license restrictions. All volunteers who may be required to drive on District business may at any time have their driving record checked by the District. If the record indicates violations, the volunteer may be subject to appropriate warnings, loss of privileges, restriction from certain duties, or disciplinary action. As a condition of continued volunteer service, each volunteer who operates a District vehicle must maintain a personal driving record which is within the risk criteria, or recommendations established by the District's insurer or by the District.

Volunteer applicant's driving records will be examined prior to being placed in active service or permitted to drive any District vehicle, as a condition of volunteer service. Volunteers who are required to drive District vehicles shall notify the Fire Chief of any change in license status, and all traffic violations. Failure to report a traffic violation or change in license status to the Fire Chief is viewed as a violation of District policy. The District monitors driving records as a component of risk management in order to identify needs for driver improvement.
