OPS-GEN – 402

Respiratory Protection

Issued: January 11, 2005

Revised: September 9, 2014

1. PURPOSE

To insure that the Respiratory Protection Program of the Yamhill Fire Protection District is consistent with Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards, and implements the provisions of Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 1914.134, and Respiratory Protection.

This is applicable to all Yamhill Fire Protection District personnel who are performing duties requiring the use of respiratory protection to prevent unnecessary exposure to airborne concentrations of toxic materials equal to or greater than the permissible limits established in existing Federal, and State occupational safety and health standards or criteria.

The District will select and provide appropriate respirators on hazard present, workplace/user factors, and respirator performance and reliability. Only respirators approved by the program administrator will be used. All respirators must be NIOSH approved.

2. GENERAL PROGRAM

Provisions for the Respiratory Program are included in the 400's Sub-sections.
