District Procedure

OPERATIONS

OPS-EMS – 506.1

Out of District Training / Recertification

Issued: September 8, 2015

PURPOSE:

The Yamhill Fire Protection District may pay for out of District training and EMT recertification. This procedure is to establish a standard for obtaining payment for classes attended outside of the Yamhill Fire Protection District.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applying for an out of District class that has a cost associated with it, you must:
 - a. Be a member in good standings with the District.
 - b. Have a minimum of 50% drill attendance. (You can submit your reasons for not meeting this requirement and it will be reviewed case-by-case.)
 - c. Respond on 10% or more of the calls yearly
2. In addition if you are going to a class for EMT or higher training, you will maintain at least a "C" level grade in the class. Plus provide two 12-hour shifts per month at the station, starting 2 months before the class starts. During the class it will be one 12 hour shift per month, for each month of the class and then 2 shifts per month for 2 months after the class ends.
3. To have the District pay for your recertification cost, you will comply with all items listed in number 1 plus you will teach 1 EMS class per year to fellow firefighters. Class topics will be determined by the Fire Chief or his/her designee.
4. Must be pre-approved by the Fire Chief before registering for the class. Request must be submitted on a District Training Form.

RESPONSIBILITY:

1. To attend the class the District has paid for or pay the District back unless it was out of your control (determine on a case by case basis).
2. To be involved in the classes and training that these classes provide.
3. Pass on information learned from the classes to the general body of the Yamhill Fire Protection District.
4. Enjoy the training.
