Code of Ethics for District Volunteers

Issued: July 8, 2014

1. Personal Interest Avoided

District volunteers may not use District equipment or services for personal interest or gain. District volunteers shall not use information or facts that came to them by virtue of their volunteer service for personal gain or benefit. Volunteers should conduct themselves in their personal and public business so as not to impair their working relationship with the District, other volunteers, officials, or the public.

2. Gifts and Gratuities

Volunteers shall not accept any special favors, gifts or gratuities resulting from or related to association with the District. In this regard, the appearance of impropriety can be as damaging as actual impropriety and shall be avoided.

3. Special Gifts

The Fire Chief or officers may allow acceptance of non-monetary gifts of nominal value (e.g., under \$50.00) at holidays or special occasions which are available to be shared by all volunteers. This sub-section in no way limits permitted contributions made to the District, directly.
