1. District ran a total of 39 calls for the month of January 2022.

2. Projects currently
 - a. We have finalized the build for the new Brush Rig. –**The Radios are in. Fouts is just waiting on Ford for the Chassis. As of last week, Ford still has not released a build date.**
3. Grants
 - a. Safer Act – **Will be resubmitting in 2023**
 - b. The AFG application wasn't awarded to us for this year. Just resubmitted for 10 sets of Turnouts and 23 pagers.
 - c. Will be working with Murray Paolo on the Homeland Security Grant for Radios. – **This grant has been submitted. Update! We have been awarded Part one of this grant which will provide 4-5 new radios for apparatus. Still waiting on Part two. Funds will not be available until September sometime. UPDATE – received word Friday evening that we have been awarded both parts for a total of \$54,680. These radios have been ordered Currently working with Murray on Phase 4 of the Radio Project for this year Homeland Security Grant.**
 - d. The district was awarded the SDAO Grant for \$6,240 which is a 50/50 grant for cybersecurity.
4. Conflagration update. Crews were deployed on 9-8-21 to Lake County. We currently have Trampas with Car-4 and Christian and Andrew with Brush 4 on this Fire. We have taken the District Water Tender and Engines off the conflagration list for the rest of this year, due to Yamhill City water conditions.
