# District Policies

**Volunteer Firefighter Point Pay**

**Issued: January 11, 2005**

**Revised: July 8, 2014**

Each budget year the District will provide funds for the volunteer firefighter point pay. The provided funds shall be divided by a number representing the total points (see below) earned by all participating volunteers. A point-per-sum will represent a monetary value for each point. Volunteers will accumulate points based on the formula beginning in December of each calendar year and continuing until November of the following year. The total points accumulated by each participating volunteer to determine total payout per volunteer will multiply the point-per-sum.

Response to call data shall determine individual point awards. It shall be the responsibility of each participating volunteer to insure an officer or incident commander records his or her name on the call data sheet or other systems, as the District directs.

The Fire Chief or their designee shall record all points earned for outside training classes.

## **POINT ALLOCATIONS**

- 1 point for responding to an alarm
- 1 point for attending a training drill
- 1 point for attending a work detail
- 1 point for attending stand-by alarms
- 1 point per day for any approved out of district training class
- 1 point per day for any approved in district training class.
