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What the District Expects from You

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This section has been arranged to present a general overview of some of the District's expectations of its volunteers. Every volunteer should keep in mind that each is a part of a team of public volunteers, and public satisfaction with the District depends upon good service. Each volunteer shall be expected to commit to the following statements:

To the People of the District of Yamhill Fire Protection District;

I affirm my commitment as a volunteer Firefighter/EMS for the Yamhill Fire Protection District, to serve the public who rely on me in times of emergency. I intend to respond and execute my duties in the proud tradition of the Fire Service to the best of my abilities. I will do so under the direction of the Fire Chief selected and appointed by the Board of Directors. I agree to act as set forth below, based upon my understanding that if we are to succeed in serving our community, every volunteer, the officers, Chief, other District staff and members of the District Board of Directors must:

- A. Treat one another with respect, honesty, courtesy and politeness without insults;
- B. Conduct ourselves in a way which upholds the traditions of the Fire Service;
- C. Train at drills and become increasingly more competent in Firefighting and EMS skills;
- D. Stop rumors and hold others and ourselves responsible for what we do and say;
- E. Become part of the solution, not the problem; and
- F. Remember that we are members of the Yamhill Fire Protection District, and we are here to serve the community.
